

Readings from the Greek New Testament

John 11:35 [3 words, 16 letters]

ἔδάκρυσεν ὁ Ἰησοῦς

1 Thess 5:16 [2 words, 14 letters]

πάντοτε χαίρετε

Matt 26:49; 27:29 (“hail, greetings, good day”) — spoken to one person

χαῖρε

Matt 28:9 (“hail, greetings, good day”) — spoken to more than one person

χαίρετε

Acts 15:23; 23:26; James 1:1 (“hail, greetings”) — in a letter

χαίρειν

Matt 5:13a

Ἵμεῖς ἐστε τὸ ἅλας τῆς γῆς·

Matt 5:14b

Ἵμεῖς ἐστε τὸ φῶς τοῦ κόσμου.

Matt 5:18a

ἀμὴν γὰρ λέγω ὑμῖν

John 1:51

ἀμὴν ἀμὴν λέγω ὑμῖν

Note: Doubled ἀμὴν ἀμὴν occurs in the N.T. only in the gospel of John, and there is found 25 times: John 1:51; 3:3; 3:5; 3:11; 5:19; 5:24; 5:25; 6:26; 6:32; 6:47; 6:53; 8:34; 8:51; 8:58; 10:1; 10:7; 12:24; 13:16; 13:20; 13:21; 13:38; 14:12; 16:20; 16:23; 21:18. The Hebrew equivalent occurs 5x in the Hebrew Bible: אָמֵן אָמֵן, (Num 5:22; Neh 8:6), אָמֵן אָמֵן Psalm 41:14: end of book 1 of Psalms; 72:19: end of book 2 of Psalms; 89:53: end of book 3 of Psalms). The Septuagint (LXX) renders doubled “amen” by *translating* instead of *transliterating*, thus γένοιτο γένοιτο (except for Neh 8:6 [LXX 2 Esdras 18:6] where it is a single Ἀμην). However, at Psalm 106:48 (LXX 105:48, end of book 4 of Psalms) LXX has γένοιτο γένοιτο where the Hebrew text has a single אָמֵן.
